Suited Combinations

- Top 10 hands - almost always good to play
- 2nd 10 hands - good, but be wary of raises and reraises or in early position
- Good to see the flop with due to the potential for monster hands if you hit straight, flush, or 3 of a kind

### Pot Odds versus Drawing Odds

# of Outs	Odds	Examples
2	22.5 to 1	a pair becoming 3 of a kind
3	14.7 to 1	pairing an unpaired card
4	10.8 to 1	inside straight draw becoming a straight, 2 pair becoming a full house
5	8.4 to 1	one pair becoming 2 pairs or 3 of a kind
6	6.8 to 1	pairing one of 2 unpaired cards
7	5.7 to 1	
8	4.9 to 1	open ended 4 card straight becoming a straight
9	4.2 to 1	4 cards of a flush becoming a flush

**Pot Odds:** The ratio of pot size compared to a bet (a \$1000 pot with a \$100 bet is 10:1)

**Drawing Odds:** The odds of making a hand from the remaining cards to be dealt (called outs) (odds are based on 47 unknown cards after the flop)

**Pot Odds vs Outs:** If pot odds are greater than drawing odds (outs) it is statistically correct to call
